### Library Schedules

- The Library is open to students during school hours until 2:45 all days except minimum days.
- Open Circulation is on Wednesdays from 8:30-10:30.
- Myford has 28 classes with a total of 815 students (and growing each day).
  - 30 minutes each week
  - Story or library lesson during visit
  - Kinder and 1<sup>st</sup> grade check-out 1 book each
  - $-2^{nd}$  through 5<sup>th</sup> grade check-out 2 books each

# Library Filing

- 3 Sections
  - Easy
  - Fiction
  - Non-Fiction
- Easy and Fiction books are filed alphabetically by the author's last name
- Non-Fiction books are filed numerically by the Dewey Decimal Classification and then alphabetically by the author's last name

### Scanning In Books

- The online circulation system will be open and ready for checkin.
  - Make sure to scan only the Myford barcode.
  - Make sure a student name appears in the list.

### Searching Titles/Authors

- On the student stations
  - Username is "*mpatron*" and password is "*student*"
  - Double-click on the "Myford Library Search" icon to open the catalog
  - Search for specific authors, titles or subjects/keywords
  - Check the status column to see if item is available
  - Look at "Call Number" to locate the material in the library
  - To find out what the book is about, click on the title to open the record
  - OPAC = Online Public Access Catalog
